

EBT (Electronic Balance Transfer)

SNAP card users:

- Customer swipes card and decides how much food money they want.
- Customer receives the number of dollars in \$1 SNAP tokens, AND the same amount (up to \$10) in double voucher coupons, which they can spend at any participating farmer or vendor for SNAP-approved food items.
- Each \$1 double voucher must be spent with a \$1 SNAP token.
- Change can NOT be given for SNAP tokens.
- Leftover SNAP tokens can be turned back in at the end of the market day and their value credited back to the customer's SNAP card.
- Farmers & vendors turn in their SNAP tokens at the end of the day and are reimbursed the following Saturday.



DEBIT card users:

- Customer swipes card and decides how much money they want to spend.
- A \$1 convenience charge is added to their desired amount to pay for the transaction and benefit the farmers market.
- Customer receives the number of dollars in \$5 debit tokens, which they can spend at any participating farmer or vendor.
- Change CAN be given for DEBIT tokens.
- Farmers & vendors turn in their debit tokens at the end of the day and are paid by check the following Saturday.
