Founded: 1975 as the Jefferson Area Board for Aging, JABA is one of 655 area agencies on aging nationwide established by the Older American Act (OAA)

Area Served: Thomas Jefferson Planning District (District 10) the city of Charlottesville and Albemarle, Fluvanna, Greene, Louisa and Nelson counties.

JABA's Organization:

JABA is comprised of three branches - JABA, JABA Inc. and JABA Elder Care.

- **JABA** stands for this Jefferson Area Board for Aging. JABA's mission is "to promote, establish and preserve sustainable communities for healthy aging that benefit individuals and families of all ages."
- **JABA Inc.** is a non-profit corporation formed in 1986. JABA Inc. acts as our entrepreneurial wing, attracting private funding, controlling JABA property, and administering fee-based programs that add to JABA's revenue.
- **JABA Elder Care** is an affiliated non-profit that operates Mountainside Senior Living, JABA's affordable, assisted living facility in Crozet, VA.
