Local Food:

JABA purchases local food through a number of sources:

- Two suppliers bring food from the Shenandoah Valle Produce Auction and represent 20-to30 different farmers.
- JABA also works directly with approximately eight to ten farmers on the eastern side of the Blue Ridge.
